AGENDA ITEMS

1. Proposed Revision to Village Code for Impervious Area. An ordinance revision was discussed for tracking impervious area in The Woods Subdivision. The Committee voted to have Rich Ramello prepare draft ordinance with input from the Village in the following areas:

- Code needs to show lot standards.
- Chart to delineate lot number in chart.
- Refer to Chapter 12 for chart.
- Village Engineer to maintain records for impervious surface area.
- Violated paragraph under routine inspection.
- Look at future property – how do we control lot coverage? Let someone know that they will have lot coverage.

2. 32-36 Wood Oaks Driveway. The Village Engineer reviewed the construction of the brick edging on the driveway construction at 36 Wood Oaks Drive. The Committee voted to have the Engineer write a letter to 36 Wood Oaks Drive requesting the portion of the driveway that is over the lot line be removed by May 1, 2009.
3. Request for Additional Signage in The Woods. The Committee reviewed the request for additional signs to be placed. The Police Department is also to complete the agreement with Toll Brothers.
4. Budget. The Committee reviewed the 2009/2010 budget and recommended submitting the budget to the Finance Committee.
5. Snowplowing. The Committee reviewed the snowplow operation and budget. The Committee recommended that the Village Engineer work with the Police Chief to direct Plote with the appropriate snow removal methods.
