ANN TAYLOR LOFT (Q-5) SIGNAGE CHANGE

Samantha Duff explained that Ann Taylor Loft is removing the name “Ann Taylor” from the store front, awning, and blade signs. The existing “LOFT” wording will remain as is.

They suggested the entire length of the sign (including name and fan design) should be balanced over the arch as its visual reference.
